# 2. How much can I donate to qualify for the tax credit?

Taxpayers filing as "single," "head of household," or "married filing separate" status may claim a maximum credit of \$400. Taxpayers that file as "married filing jointly" may claim a maximum credit of \$800. You don't have to itemize deductions to claim a credit for contributions to a qualifying charitable organization.
